Wanted: Candidates for the San Lorenzo Village Board of Directors

The regular election process for two board positions will begin this month. Both Kathy Martins and Margaret Wright's terms will expire. The two incumbents are running for another three year term. In addition there is an open two-year seat due to Wulf Bieschke's resignation. If four or more candidates run for election, the two top vote getters will be installed to each of the three year terms. The third highest vote getter will complete the two years remaining on Wulf's term. If three persons run, the incumbents will assume the regular three year terms, and the third person will complete the vacant two year term. Homeowners that run for the Board of Directors become a part of the system that makes the difference for yourself and your community. You take on an important role as a leader in determining the future of San Lorenzo. It is your chance to make a difference and take an active part in our community. Board Members of San Lorenzo Village Homes deal with management of our physical assets, money and other resources, contracts and liabilities. The Board of Directors is composed of five unpaid volunteers. Each term is for three years. The Board meets twice a month to review and make decisions about our finances, common area maintenance, legal issues, committee proposals, and countless issues affecting San Lorenzo's property values. They also attend several community meetings and events.

Q: Tell us more about Street Sweeping
