California Lottery names San Lorenzo Shop its "Retailer of the Year"

SAN LORENZO — Kavanagh Liquors in San Lorenzo is officially the luckiest place in the Bay Area to buy lottery tickets. The store, at 500 Via Mercado, has seen four multi million-dollar wins since 1989, with

an unclaimed \$28.5 million winning ticket sold in 2003 and a \$38,583 winner last Saturday, making it the fourth-luckiest spot in the state to purchase tickets.

Representatives of the California Lottery Commission were in town Wednesday to present Kavanagh Liquors the "Retailer of the Month" award. Store manager David Spahn received a \$1,500 check and offered customers a chance to spin a wheel for prizes. The store is now in the running for the "Retailer of the Year" award and a \$5,000 prize. "They do tremendous volume," said Robert Morgan, California Lottery sales manager for the East Bay, adding that community service was a factor in the award. Lottery spokeswoman Norma Minas said Kavanagh Liquors donates money to local high schools and the Boy Scouts. "Their enthusiasm is great," Minas said. "Having four jackpots is a big thing. People come out here to buy tickets because they think it's a lucky location." Kavanagh Liquors has sold \$27 million in tickets since 1985, and \$9.5 million of that has gone to education, according to Mike Brennan, Lottery deputy director of sales and marketing.

The Association thanks Kavanagh for their many years of service to the Community.

We have asked the redevelopment agency to join us and give a presentation about current land acquisitions and the Hesperian Streetscape Project.

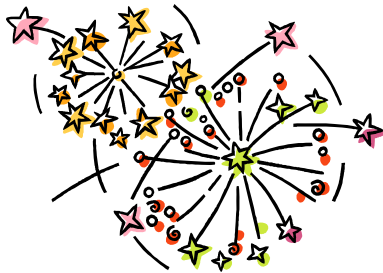

Q: *I was sent a letter about my lawn, however my neighbor down the street did not receive a letter. Why is this?*

A: *There are several reasons why your neighbor may have not received a letter yet. When staff drives by if the lawn has not reached 10 to 12 inches of grass, we usually wait to send a letter, since we know often times residents can only mow on weekends. Another reason would be that we have been unable to verify the homeowner's address or perhaps we know the house is in foreclosure and we haven't been able to determine what bank currently owns the property. Finally, sometimes staff knows the property has been referred to the County's Neighborhood Preservation Ordinance staff and thus county staff is dealing with it.*

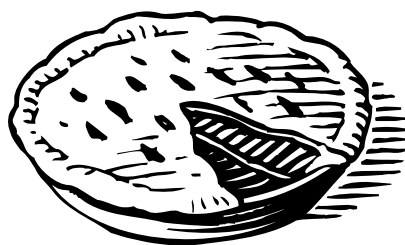
