Do you have questions on downtown? The Lorenzo Theater?

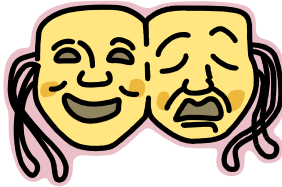
We have asked the redevelopment agency to join us and give a presentation about current land acquisitions and the Hesperian Streetscape Project. It shouldn't be missed!!!

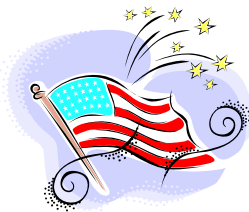
